National Central University College of Science Regulations on Establishment of the Curriculum Committee

Approved by the NCU Curriculum Committee on March 6, 2024

1. The “College of Science Curriculum Committee” (hereafter referred to as “the Committee”) is to be established in accordance with Article 3 of the NCU Regulations on Establishment of Curriculum Committees.
2. The Committee is responsible for planning and integrating the common courses, general education courses, and specialist courses between different departments and graduate institutes, and for reviewing course-related matters from each department and graduate institute.
3. The Dean or Deputy Dean of the College of Science is an ex officio member of the Committee. Each Department, graduate institute, and the Interdisciplinary Program of Science shall nominate a teacher representative to the Committee. The Dean or Deputy Dean will serve as the convener, and all the committee members are appointed for one year. The convener may invite one NCU/non-university expert/scholar, and one industrial representative as attendees if necessary.
4. The Committee shall be convened to hold regular meetings at least once per semester, with the possibility of convening extraordinary meetings if needed.
5. These Regulations were approved by the College Affairs Committee, College of Science and submitted to the NCU Curriculum Committee for review and approval before implementation, and also submitted to the Academic Affairs Committee, College of Science for future reference. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
