National Central University College of Science Regulations for Teaching Excellence Awards

Approved by the College Affairs Committee in March, 2011

- Article 1 These Regulations were stipulated by the College of Science (hereafter referred to as "the College") to enhance teaching quality, reward teachers for teaching excellence, and recognize their teaching performance.
- Article 2 All full-time and jointly appointed faculty members and researchers who have taught more than four full semesters at NCU and who satisfy the basic teaching hours set for teachers of each level by the NCU in the two preceding years with outstanding teaching performance may be nominated as candidates. The evaluation criteria for candidates may include:
 - -Teaching philosophy and methodology;
 - -Teaching evaluations for compulsory courses, core general education courses, or courses with lots of students;
 - -Records of interviews with students who take the courses:
 - -Numbers of students who take the courses;
 - -Course materials and information prepared by the corresponding teachers.
- Article 3 Faculty members who receive the award are presented with a cash price of NT\$120,000 for one year.
- Article 4 Each department/graduate institute in the College may nominate teachers for teaching excellence awards at the College level at the end of March each year. The number of candidates nominated by each department/research institute shall, in principle, not exceed 10% (rounded up) of their full-time faculty members. Nominations should include the Nomination Form and meeting minutes. The Nomination Form should provide a brief description of the outstanding teacher's teaching philosophy, methodology, and accomplishments over the past two years.
- Article 5 Judges for the College Teaching Excellence Award shall be recommended by the College Executive Committee. A number of people from the list shall be recommended for the "NCU Outstanding Teaching Award" and "NCU Teaching Excellence Award" for approval by the College-Level Faculty Evaluation Committee.
- Article 6 These Regulations were passed by the College Affairs Committee and subsequently submitted to the Academic Affairs Committee for approval before implementation. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
